This is your invitation to honor a woman for the Annual Women's History Remembering Project, held by the Douglas County Historical Society to commemorate Women's History Month.

This project was inspired by the National Women's History Project and the Nevada Women's History Project. It is designed to collect the stories of Douglas County women who might otherwise be forgotten. All information collected will be archived in the library at the Carson Valley Museum and Cultural Center in Gardnerville and also at the Nevada Women's History Project in Reno.

Nomination Criteria

1. The woman you wish to honor must have lived in Douglas County
2. The woman you wish to honor should have made a significant historical contribution to the quality of life in Douglas County.

The honoree form must be accompanied by a double-spaced typewritten biographical presentation, and a 5" x 7" photograph for display at the event. *(Please submit a copy of your original photo. This will not be returned to you, but will be kept in the archives at the Douglas County Historical Society.)* We will honor the first six submitted.

There will be an exhibit designed around the photos and memorabilia related to the honorees. If you bring one item to the museum about two weeks before the event, it will be included in the exhibit. All memorabilia will be exhibited for about one year and then returned to you.

The deadline for submission is March 1, 2017

If you would like to nominate a Douglas County woman, you, or a person you designate, will be asked to make a 5-minute presentation on the day of the event. If you have any questions, please call the office at 782-2555.
