SETUP: Entries are to be delivered to the Carson Valley Museum & Cultural Center, 1477 Highway 395 N., Gardnerville Saturday, November 25 or the week of Monday, November 27 through Friday, December 1, between the hours of 10:00 AM to 3:30 PM.

RECEPTION: The exhibit opens 10:00 AM at the museum's Holiday Gala on Saturday, December 2 and runs through Saturday, December 16. An artisan's reception will be held on December 16 from Noon to 2:00 PM. The winners will be announced at the Artisan's Reception.

PICK-UP: Entries may be taken home after the artisan's reception. All remaining entries must be picked-up on or before Tuesday, January 2. The Historical Society reserves the right to donate unclaimed entries.

Contest Rules and Guidelines:

- 1) You may choose any winter/Christmas theme, inside a jar or under glass for your entry. No water inside the globe or glitter outside the globe will be accepted.
- 2) Maximum size of 30 inches in circumference and 15 inches overall height. No minimum.
- 3) You may include a low-wattage battery-operated light in the snowglobe interior. Museum staff is not available to turn lights on and off.
- 4) Contents are only limited by your imagination. Any decorations outside the glass must be secured to the snowglobe. Glitter acceptable on Inside only.
- 5) The Historical Society reserves the right to photograph entries for promotional purposes. The Historical Society assumes no responsibility for the safety of the waterless snowglobes.
