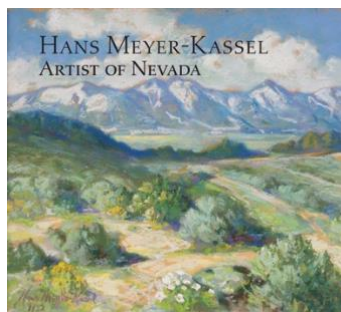

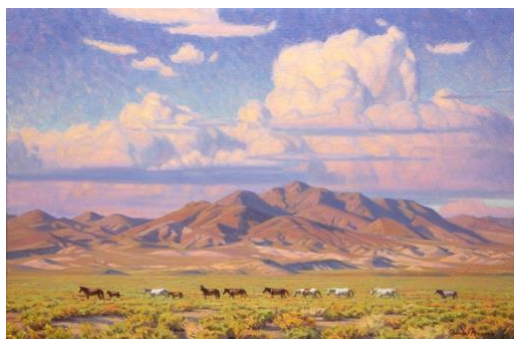


Exhibit of Fine Art – Special Invite **6:00 p.m. Friday, June 22** **Carson Valley Museum & Cultural Center**
