2. Store bought gingerbread kits may be used but be sure to add additional decorative candies and features to personalize your entry!
3. Holiday decorations and figurines may be used to accessorize your entry.
4. NEW for 2019: Please limit your display board not to exceed 20" wide by 24" deep. If your group wished to do an oversized feature entry, please contact the coordinator.
5. Soft cake, soft frostings and other moist perishable items are not allowed.
6. Electric lights are allowed.

SETUP: Entries must be delivered to the Carson Valley Museum & Cultural Center, 1477 Highway 395 N, Gardnerville from Friday, November 28 through Friday, December 6 between the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. The museum is closed on Sunday. Bring your house and application to the museum. No advanced registration or fee is required.

EXHIBIT & RECEPTION: The exhibit opens 10:00 a.m. at the museum's Holiday Gala on Saturday, December 7 and runs through Saturday, December 21. An artisan's reception will be held on the 21st from Noon to 2:00 p.m. Ribbons will be awarded at the Artisan's Reception.

PICK UP: Entries may be taken home after the artisan's reception. All remaining entries must be picked up on or before Friday, December 27. The CVAC reserves the right to donate unclaimed entries.
