Barns such as these were the most conspicuous structures along the Carson River route. Barns dwarfed dwellings and were impressively related to the source of pioneer power – horsepower.

When there was a blacksmith nearby, the barn became the service station of their time.

The variety of roof styles suggests that there were several sources from which the builders took their designs.
