1. Houses may be either traditional (made of edible food substances) or non-traditional "Fantasy" houses consisting of anything from Legos, play dough, crocheted, origami, or whatever craft inspires your imagination!
2. Store bought gingerbread kits may be used but be sure to add additional decorative candies and features to personalize your entry!
3. Holiday decorations and figurines may be used to accessorize your entry.
4. Please limit your display board not to exceed 20" wide by 24" deep. If you or your group wish to do an oversized "Feature" entry, please contact the coordinator.
5. Soft cake, soft frostings and other moist perishable items are not allowed.
6. LED or low wattage electric lights are allowed.

SETUP: Bring your house and application to the Carson Valley Museum & Cultural Center, 1477 Highway 395 N, Gardnerville. Available dates and times are: Friday & Saturday, November 27 - 28, 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. and Monday through Friday, November 30 – December 4 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. All Gingerbread Houses must be in place by 3:00 p.m. Friday, December 4

EXHIBIT & RECEPTION: The Gingerbread House display opens 10:00 a.m. at the museum's Holiday Gala on Saturday, December 5, and runs through Saturday, December 19. An artisan's reception will be held on the 19th from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Ribbons will be awarded at the Artisan's Reception.

PICK UP: Entries may be taken home after the artisan's reception. All remaining entries must be picked up on or before Friday, January 8. The DCHS reserves the right to donate unclaimed entries.
