

Gallery of Trees

Rules & Requirements:

The Douglas County Historical Society is a 501(c)(3) domestic non-profit corporation. IRS code prohibits us from engaging in any activity that lends endorsement of a political candidate or a current political cause. All trees must reflect the historic, cultural or community service offered by your 501(c)(3).

1. The preferred size of the Christmas Tree should be six to eight feet tall and approximately three to four feet in diameter. If you have an extra-large tree, please contact us.
2. Only flame-retardant trees are allowed. No live foliage or fresh perishable decorations are permitted. This includes items such as popcorn, cranberries, flowers and holly.
3. Loose glitter, confetti, tinsel, soil, wood chips or spray-on snow is not allowed. Ornaments with glitter should be sprayed with shellac.
4. Use only mini-lights, LED preferred.
5. Accessory themed decorations may be placed under the tree, but please be sure they are unbreakable and do not present a tripping hazard. A minimum 36" walking corridor must be maintained between the trees.
6. Please bring your own decorated advertising rack, basket, or a gift-wrapped box to include literature about your business, organization or charity.
7. Douglas County Historical Society is not responsible for fire, theft, or damage of tree.
